C) GEAX NEURON TNT

Available in 2.3 and 2.5" sizes with a stout two-ply casing, Geax's Neuron is a fast downhill tire for dry conditions. It is available in two versions - TNT and UST. TNT is Geax's Tube No Tube technology, which can be made tubeless with the use of their Pit Stop latex tire sealant, and the UST is the tubeless model. The TNT and UST models use a dual compound rubber. The Neuron runs fast, vertical center knobs and staggered side lugs with a slight gap between the inner and outer knobs.

We tested the 2.5" Neuron TNT model. Geax's dual compound features rubber that is slightly firmer than most downhill tires, using 60 down the center tread and 50 on the side knobs. The dual compound and tread pattern make for a quick tire that carries speed and offers decent braking and good cornering traction. It has a consistent feel while rolling over to the cornering knobs that instills confidence during moderate and aggressive turning angles. This is a dry condition tire only and works well on all types of arid terrain, including rocks, hardpack and jagged mixes of debris.
